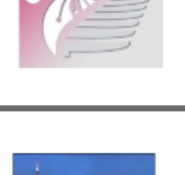

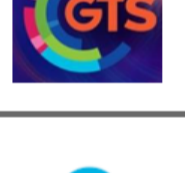

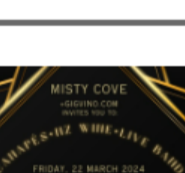

**Engagement session on Hong Kong
Minimum Top-up Tax under BEPS 2.0
Friday 12 January 2024**

The Financial Secretary announced in the 2023-24 Budget that Hong Kong planned to apply the global minimum effective tax rate of 15 per cent on multinational enterprise groups with annual consolidated revenue of at least EUR 750 million under the BEPS 2.0 package and implement the HKMITT starting from 2025 onwards. The Financial Services and the Treasury Bureau (FSTB) has commenced a consultation exercise to gather views on the specific implementation issues on or before 20 March 2024.
